



# CODE OF CONDUCT

The Boyne Burnett Inland Rail Trail is for walking, cycling and horse riding only. Except for motorised wheelchairs & e-bikes, motorised vehicles are not permitted.

**On the trail, respect other users, the environment and privacy of adjacent landholders. Please observe the following:**

- Keep on the rail trail.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- Take your rubbish home with you.
- Fires are prohibited on the trail except in designated sidings.
- Camp in designated areas only.
- Clean your bike, shoes, equipment, horses' hooves & coats before and after your trip.
- Avoid riding on soft, wet and muddy tracks.
- Move quietly and quickly past livestock with care.
- Dogs are permitted on the trail on a leash. Adjoining landholders may carry out baiting from time to time. Cows with young calves sometimes aggressively chase dogs.
- Do not interfere with native plants or animals.
- Alert other users, especially horse riders when approaching from behind. Pass quietly at a reduced speed or stop.
